



APPROVED FIRST AID QUALIFICATIONS FOR CHILDREN'S SERVICES STAFF

The *Dictionary* in the *Children's Service's Regulation 2004* (the Regulation) aligns first aid qualifications which are approved for the purpose of the Regulation with first aid courses which are approved by the WorkCover Authority of NSW.

Subject to a transitional arrangement (see below), from 1 July 2009 a first aid qualification is an 'approved first aid qualification' under the Regulation only if it was gained on completion of a course that included one of the following competencies:

- **HLTFA301B Apply First Aid**

OR

- **HLTFA402B Apply Advanced First Aid.**

Transitional arrangement

If, before 1 July 2009, a person gained a first aid qualification which was an approved qualification under the Regulation at the time it was gained, that person will still have an approved first aid qualification for the purposes of the Regulation for as long as the person's qualification certificate remains current.
