 <p>ADRA</p>	<p>emergency accommodation</p>	<p>ADRA provides emergency accommodation assistance to people affected by disasters.</p>
 <p>Anglicare</p>		<p>Anglicare provides general support to other welfare services participating organisations who require increased capacity during emergency operations.</p>
 <p>Australian Red Cross</p>	<p>personal support</p>	<p>The Australian Red Cross provides personal support services including care and comfort, information, referral, interpersonal help and other measures such as outreach.</p>
 <p>The Salvation Army</p>	<p>catering</p>	<p>The Salvation Army arranges food and refreshments for disaster affected people and welfare services agency workers.</p>
 <p>St Vincent de Paul Society</p>	<p>material and personal requisites</p>	<p>The St Vincent de Paul Society assists evacuees by providing basic necessities such as clothing, blankets, and personal requisites where required.</p>
